Special Notes

- ◆ Games will be nine innings or two hours and forty-five minutes, whichever comes first. No inning will begin after: 11:45 am for game 1, 2:30 p.m. for game 2, 5:15 p.m. for game 3
- ◆ Teams participating in Game 2 should convene at Gate A (left field porch) at 11:00 a.m. At that time, players will receive their game jersey and teams will be escorted to the batting cages and bullpens.
- ◆ All players participating in Game 3 should convene at Gate A (left field porch) at 1:50 p.m. At that time, players will receive their game jersey and teams will be escorted to the batting cages and bullpens.
- ◆ Home teams will use the third base dugout; visiting teams will use the first-base dugout.
- ◆ Both teams will use visiting team bullpen in right field bullpen for warming up pitchers.
- ◆ **A concession stand will be open to serve everyone in attendance.** No beverage of any kind will be allowed in Progressive Field.
- ◆ Specific restrooms and general seating areas will be designated for fans.
- ◆ Fans, coaches, and players will receive no parking privileges and all must exit Progressive Field 30 minutes after the conclusion of the last game.
- ◆ Teams will line up in front of their respective dugouts at the conclusion of each game for a team photo.
- ◆ At the conclusion of your game, please clean up the dugout and double check for all equipment. **We are not responsible for any lost or stolen equipment.**
- ◆ If the All-Star Game is postponed due to inclement weather on June 19th, this entire schedule will simply be moved to another date YTBD, based on field use and availability.
- ◆ **Major League Baseball and The Cleveland Indians do not permit anyone on the field under the age of sixteen. In addition, only players and coaches in uniform will be allowed on the field.**
